With the consent of all parties, Defendants write to advise the court that the parties have conferred and are jointly amenable to administrative termination of this action, without prejudice to any party's right to make a letter request to restore this matter to the active docket at an appropriate time.¹ This would include, but is not limited to, cancellation of Defendants' pending September 18, 2020 deadline to answer, move, or otherwise reply to Plaintiffs' complaint.

¹ This comes, among other things, following Governor Murphy's issuance of Executive Order No. 183 (Sept. 1, 2020), which permitted with certain restrictions the reopening of indoor entertainment centers such as indoor movie theaters, including consumption of concessions. A copy of this Executive Order is attached.
