



Capturing an IRC-28C Log

The IRC-28C produces a streaming log on TCP port 10001. You can capture this log and add time stamps using Tera Term (a Windows application).


1. Download Tera Term from <http://ftp.uslinc.com/ftp/MultiProduct/teraterm-4.83.exe>
2. Install Tera Term
3. Start Tera Term.



4. Enter the IP address of the IRC-28C. Set the service to other. Set the TCP port number to 10001. Press OK.
5. You should see a window like that below with log messages from the IRC-28C.



6. Click File – Log to get the logging dialog box shown below.



7. Set a path and filename for the log. Check Timestamp to add a timestamp to the log. Click Save.
8. A second Tera Term task (called Tera Term Log) will be added to the task bar. Open this task to pause or stop the log.

It's usually helpful to let logging run for a couple shows so we can see long term operation of the system.
